## HOCH<sup>N</sup>: Network



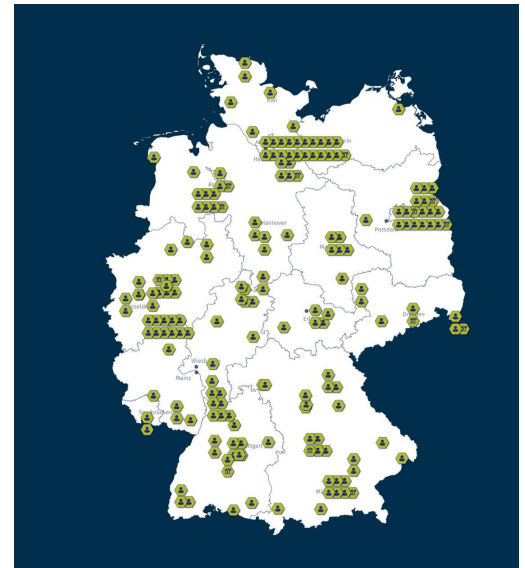

All researchers, teachers, students and administrative higher education staff are invited to participate.
